

ACTIVE DIRECTORY DATABASE AND USERS LOGIN

Starting in 1.7.15 version, cardPresso supports Active Directory⁽¹⁾ as a data source and users logins (read-only).

DATABASE SOURCE USERS LOGIN

(1) Available in XXL edition . Windows only.



1. DATABASE SOURCE

This new feature allows you to use Active Directory data in your cards.

The connection to Active Directory is read-only, the data will never be modified or deleted on the server side.


The connection to the Active Directory is done securely with SSL.



DATABASECONNECTION WIZARD

- Database Driver selection > Select **«Active Directory** Database Driver»
- Database connection configuration > Choose the Active Directory server to connect.
- Database operation > Select table (all Active Directory object classes found are listed in the list)
- **Choose the columns of your tables** (all properties related to the previously selected object class are displayed)

After finishing the connection wizard, the Active Directory has been successfully open as a database.



2. USERS LOGIN

It is possible to add users that are authenticated using Active Directory

With this feature it is possible to add users that are authenticated using Active Directory, allowing users to authenticate in cardPresso with the same credentials that are used in Windows.

The connection to Active Directory is read-only, the data will never be modified or deleted on the server side.

The connection to the Active Directory is done securely with SSL.



NEW USER OPTIONS



LINK ACTIVE DIRECTORY USER

This will add a new user that will use Active Directory for authentication.



UNLINK ACTIVE DIRECTORY USER


This allows removing an Active Directory user from cardPresso's users (This will **not** delete the user in the Active Directory server. The connection to the server is read-only).




ACTIVE DIRECTORY SETTINGS

This option allows specifying the URL of the Active Directory server to connect to. If left empty, cardPresso will use the computer's default Active Directory server.

The login dialog works with regular cardPresso users, but now also accepts added Active Directory users.



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
